Conditions of Entry to the Bush Poetry Competition.

Non-original means by a recognized author. Permission must be granted by the author unless it is a traditional poem (written before 1950) and out of copyright.

For children of primary school and high school age, there is only one category in which the entrant can present either an original or non-original poem.

Walk-up entries on the day of the competition can be submitted from 8 am, but pre-entries will be given priority.

Performances must be 'family friendly.'

The Festival of the Fleeces Committee reserves the right to refuse entry to any candidate for any reason. The Judge's decision is final.

When: Sunday 11th June.

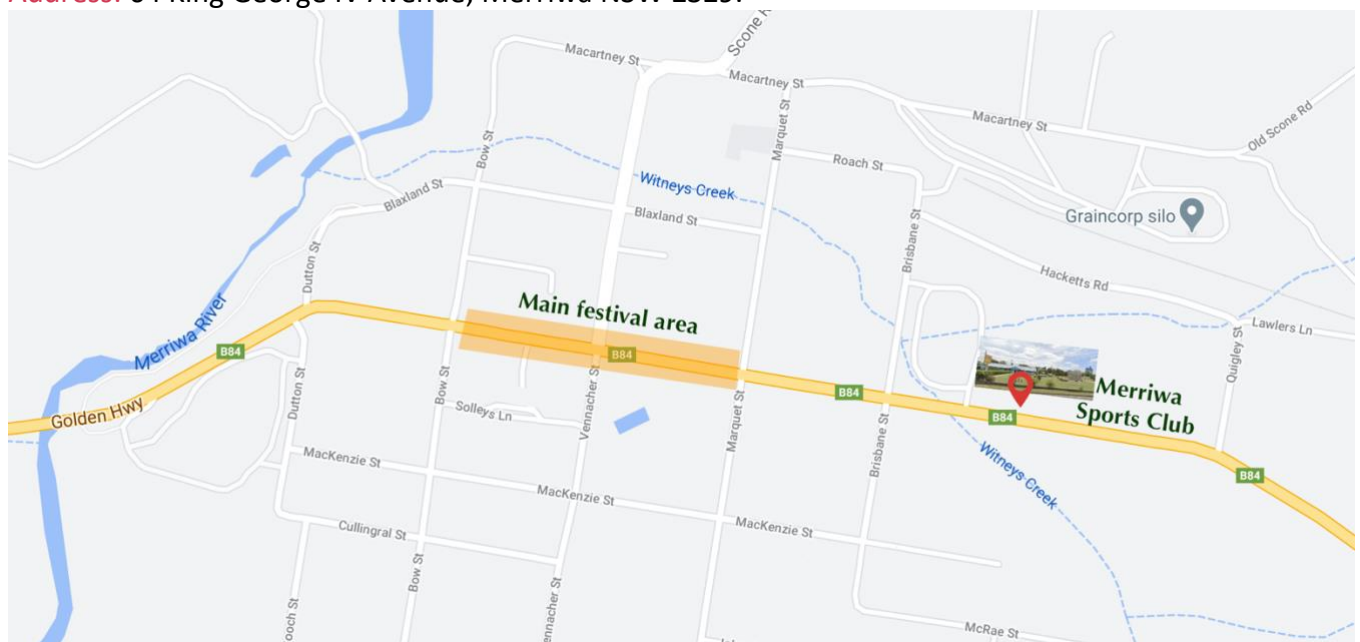
Breakfast: Starts at 8am.
